Kimberly Jenkins is co-founder and CEO of Women on the Verge Network (WOVN), a network of women with highly successful careers as senior leaders in financial services, information technology, media, healthcare, professional services, public policy, and law. WOVN's mission is to accelerate the success of women as leaders---one woman at a time.

For the past three years, Kimberly has served as a part-time faculty member and mentor to students in the Masters in Engineering Management Program in the Duke University Pratt School of Engineering. Her teaching and speaking engagements focus primarily on issues related to increasing the number and effectiveness of women and minorities in entrepreneurial careers. She currently teaches leadership courses in the business schools of both Duke University and the University of North Carolina.

Kimberly, a graduate of Duke University (BS 1976, PhD 1980), is the former President of the Internet Policy Institute, an independent, nonprofit research and educational institute that examines global Internet policy issues. She was also the Founder, Chairman and President of Highway 1, a nonprofit corporation focused on helping the federal government operate more effectively through the use of information technologies.

During her career in management Kimberly created Microsoft's Education Division, ran market development at NeXT, and worked as a technical analyst for Control Data Corporation. She has also served as a consultant to companies such as Microsoft, Apple, Sun, Oracle and Cisco.

Kimberly currently serves on the Duke University Board of Trustees, where she chairs the Committee for Institutional Advancement. She is also a member of the Duke University Health Systems Board, Vice Chair of the Kenan Institute for Ethics Board, an advisory board member of Duke's Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation, and a trustee of the National Humanities Center.
